Virtual tour at the House of Parliament

The building of Hungary's law-making body, the House of Parliament, is rightly considered among the most beautiful parliament buildings in the world. Selected as a World Heritage site as a central element in the Danube panorama in 2011, the edifice is not only an invaluable treasure, but also the pride of the nation. It provides a home for the legislature, a place of safekeeping for the Hungarian Holy Crown, and a workplace both for the 199 Members of Parliament and for the nearly 600 people who assist them.

Even though, the descriptions of the virtual tour are currently only available in Hungarian, it really worth visiting, thus you can see our stunning Parliament from the inside.
